Project Name: **MILTON STREET PARK PROJECT**
12500 MILTON STREET, LOS ANGELES, CA 90066

Type of Work: This project includes but is not limited to: The furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, services and incidental necessary for Work, as indicated in the plans and specifications, for the 1.2 acre Milton Street Park and Street Improvements located at 12500 Milton Street, Los Angeles, CA. Work includes but is not limited to site demolition (vegetative, asphalt, concrete, and misc.), rough grading, fine grading, pedestrian walkway, a shade structure, new access gateway, entry stairs, ADA work, accessible ramps, fencing, native landscape and irrigation, site furnishings, gabion and retaining walls, interpretive panels, benches, concrete, asphalt and decomposed gravel paving.

The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority, a local public agency exercising joint powers of Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy, the Conejo Recreation and Park District, and the Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District pursuant to Section 6500, *et seq.* of the Government Code, requests bids for the above referenced project, complete and in place at 12500 Milton Street, Los Angeles, CA 90066. At the time of bid submission, and at all times during the term of the contract, the Contractor shall hold a Class A or B General Contractors license issued by the State of California.

Bids must be received by 2 p.m. on May 16, 2014 in the main office of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority at 570 W. Avenue 26, Suite 100, Los Angeles, CA, 90065. Plans, bid forms, and specifications are non-refundable and may be viewed for free and purchased by the contractor from ARC Reprographics, 628 Allen Ave, Glendale (818) 241-4181 beginning April 9th, 2014. Bidders must register at the mandatory Bidder's conference, held at 10 a.m. on Wednesday April 16, 2014 at the project site, 12500 Milton Street, Los Angeles, CA 90066. All bidders shall park on Milton Street within the project boundaries. Please call Blaine Yoder at (760) 801-3849 if you have any directional questions or get lost. All potential bidders shall attend this pre-bid meeting to become registered. Failure to do so may result in rejection of bid. Prospective bidders must register in order to receive notice of Addenda.

The provisions of the California Labor Code will be incorporated in and govern this contract. The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the general

prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Department of Industrial Relations, copies of which are on file with the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority and will be made available upon request. This project is a public works project, as defined in Labor Code Section 1720, and must be performed in accordance with the requirements of Labor Code sections 1720 to 1815 and Title 8 CCR sections 16000 to 17270, which govern the payment of prevailing wage rates on public works projects. MRCA has adopted a Labor Compliance Program, which states that construction contracts under \$25,000 and maintenance contracts under \$15,000 will not be subject to prevailing wages.

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
