The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA), a local public agency exercising joint powers, is seeking bidders for the construction of the 1.1 acre Park to Playa Trail – Stocker Corridor Project located within the Baldwin Hills in Los Angeles California. Work includes, but is not limited to: site demolition (vegetative, asphalt, concrete, and misc.), rough grading, fine grading, decomposed granite and native soil surfaced trails, concrete pedestrian walkways, Strata Slope retaining walls, parking lot, storm drain, new entry signage with CMU monument structures, wood fencing, site furnishings and irrigation and planting. At the time of bid submission, and at all times during the term of the contract, the Contractor shall hold a Class A General Engineering Contractors license issued by the State of California. This project is a public works project as defined in Labor Code Section 1720 and must be performed in accordance with the requirements of the California Labor Code.
