APPROXIMATELY 0.5-ACRE CONSERVATION EASEMENT FOR CROSS-
MULHOLLAND DRIVE WILDLIFE MOVEMENT PURPOSES
ON APN 4385-021-010 BENEDICT CANYON,
CITY OF LOS ANGELES

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that the area of the proposed conservation easement on APN 4385-021-010 is ecologically significant; and
2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated November 4, 2009; and
4. AUTHORIZES acceptance of a conservation easement over a portion of APN 4385-021-010 at 13850 Mulholland Drive in Benedict Canyon; and
5. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
