SUBJECT: **Agenda Item VI(g): Consideration of resolutions (a) ordering the making of amended assessments pursuant to Part 10 of Division 10 of the California Streets and Highways Code and (b) preliminarily approving amended assessments and setting a public hearing for the Santa Monica Mountains Open Space Preservation Assessment District No. 2.**

Staff Recommendation: That the Governing Board adopt the attached resolutions (a) ordering the making of amended assessments pursuant to Part 10 of Division 10 of the California Streets and Highways Code and (b) preliminarily approving amended assessments and setting a public hearing for the Santa Monica Mountains Open Space Preservation Assessment District No. 2.

Background: On August 21, 2002, in its Resolution No. 02-107, this Board adopted the Engineer's Report, Confirmed the Assessment and directed related actions for the Santa Monica Mountains Open Space Preservation Assessment District No. 2 under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of California (the "Act"). On March 11, 2003, limited obligation improvement bonds were sold in the manner provided by the Improvement Bond Act of 1915, Division 10 of the Streets and Highways Code (the "Bond Law"). Under the Bond Law, each year the Board must take action to amend the assessment for the payment of debt service on the assessment district bonds. The Bond Law requires the annual preparation of an engineer's report in order to accurately reflect divisions, mergers or other changes with respect to the original lots, pieces and parcels of and within the assessment district which have occurred since the prior report. Resolution No. 06-84(a) orders the making of the amended assessments. Resolution No. 06-84(b) would preliminarily approve the amended assessments as set forth in the Engineer's Report and set the date, time and place for the required public hearing.
