## **PARK RANGER JOB OPPORTUNITY BULLETIN**

The Park Ranger protects agency parkland and resources and performs a wide variety of park maintenance, law enforcement, first aid, wildland firefighting and public safety patrol; assists the public in natural resources interpretation; provides vehicle and equipment maintenance, and other duties as assigned.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Provide a wide range of Law Enforcement and Public Safety services including, but not limited to Wildland Firefighting, Search & Rescue and First Aid
- Respond to emergency situations on parkland to protect life and property
- Perform routine maintenance and repairs on agency vehicles and other equipment
- Maintain park trails and service roads
- Remove graffiti as necessary; and clean up all litter and illegal dumping
- Coordinate with organized public groups utilizing park facilities
- Coordinate with outside crews working on parkland
- Direct traffic and parking as needed
- Operate with substantial independence and coordinate work with others in completing assignments
- Perform heavy physical labor; including lifting and carrying items weighing up to 90 pounds a distance of up to 50 feet
- Conduct interpretive kayak programs
- Perform related duties as required

**Two years of public safety experience is recommended for appointment (previous park ranger, river safety, lifeguard, law enforcement, fire or EMS experience).**

### **REQUIRED SKILLS FOR APPOINTMENT:**

- Meet requirements of Government Sections 1031 for employment as a California Peace Officer
- Ability to complete a Level III Reserve Academy or higher
- Must be at least 21 years old at time of appointment
- Possess a valid California Drivers License with satisfactory driving record. (Must provide DMV printout)
- First Aid/CPR for the professional rescuer or equivalent
- Maintain the ability to carry a firearm and qualify quarterly with the issued firearm(s).

**Compensation:** \$18.23 per hour as a trainee  
\$23.33 – 28.35 per hour/Full Time Appointment

**REQUIRED HOURS:** 40 hours per week, must be available to work nights, weekends and holidays.

**BENEFITS:** Health insurance, life insurance, retirement, vacation, sick leave and paid holidays.
